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## 1 Data Introduction

This package provides two lightweight datasets for those wishing to try out the examples within the *flowFit* package.

The package contains two datasets:

1. PKH26data
2. QuahAndParish

## 2 Loading the data

The example datasets can be loaded using the `data` function.
